

- **HISTORICAL CITY CENTRE AND LJUBLJANA CASTLE €17/USD 20.00**



The tour, beginning in front of the Town Hall, takes you through the historical city centre, whose unique architecture is the legacy of the Baroque and Art Nouveau periods and, most notably, the work of the famous 20th century architect Jože Plečnik. The tour includes a stop at one of Ljubljana's restaurants, where you will have an opportunity to taste traditional Slovenian dishes as part of a brief tasting session.

Ljubljana Castle, standing on a hill above the city for about 900 years, is Ljubljana's main attraction. On this tour, you will learn about its history and enjoy beautiful city views afforded by the castle's ramparts.

The price includes guidance, a tasting session, and a return funicular ride to Ljubljana Castle.

Ljubljana is called “the city of vine and wine”, because it is situated at the crossroads of the wine-growing Mediterranean, Karst, Alps and Pannonian Basin regions. At carefully chosen stopover sites and in the company of local wine connoisseurs you can taste a selection of the best that the Podravje, Posavje and Primorska wine regions have to offer. Wine tastings also include snacks. At the Ljubljana Castle you can take a look at a descendant of the world’s oldest vine (from the Lent embankment area in Maribor).The price includes a 3-hour professional tour with a wine

connoisseur guide, 3 tastings of Slovenian wines (9 varieties, three wine-growing regions) and snacks, ride in a funicular to the Ljubljana Castle.

- **LJUBLJANA BEER EXPERIENCE €38/USD 45.00**



Ljubljana has a very long tradition of brewing, proof of which are 3,900-year-old beer barrels excavated at the Ljubljana Marshes. The earliest known brewery in Ljubljana dates back at least to 1592, and by 1796, the city had six breweries. Recent years have seen a rapid growth in the popularity of craft beers made by different microbreweries in Ljubljana and its surrounding area. During the tour, you will visit five different drink outlets, including a pub, where you will taste seven different beers made by five different breweries, two based in Ljubljana and three in other parts of the Central Slovenia region. You will also visit the

Brewery Museum, set up by the Pivovarna Union brewery, where the popular Union beer has been brewed since 1864, and round off your experience at the Pivnica Union pub. The price includes expert guidance, beer tasting sessions, snacks, and a tour of Pivovarna Union's Brewery Museum.

- **POSTOJNA CAVES & PREDJAMA CASTLE (UNDERGROUND TREASURES AND LEGENDS) €74/USD 88.00**



This excursion includes a tour of the famous Postojna Caves, the world's biggest underground cave complex, and a visit to the nearby Predjama Castle, built into a cave in a vertical cliff face.

The Postojna Caves, one of Slovenia's most notable natural sights, consist of a 27-kilometre system of underground caves, tunnels, galleries and halls with spectacular dripstones. A small cave train will take you on a tour around the caves, which are also known for providing habitat for

Proteus anguinus, an endemic amphibian salamander. Predjama Castle, part of which is built into the middle of a 123 metre high vertical cliff face, was originally home of the legendary outcast knight Erasmus. The present castle, which was given its Renaissance appearance in the 16th century, houses a museum.

The price includes transfers, guidance, and admission to the Postojna Caves and Predjama Castle.

- **ALPINE LAKES (BLED & BOHINJ) €59/USD 70.00**



During this excursion to Bled and Bohinj, Slovenia's most beautiful alpine lake resorts, you will learn about the local history and see the area's major sights. Bled became a popular tourist resort in the 19th century, when the Swiss doctor Arnold Rikli discovered the beneficial properties of the area's natural resources and founded a health centre there. Bled's premier attractions are a lake of glacial origin with an island in the middle and a castle whose history dates back to the 11th century. The Alpine Lakes excursion includes a tour of the town of Bled, a visit to Bled Castle and a traditional "pletna" boat ride to Bled Island. At the Bohinj lake resort, famous for its unspoiled nature, you will visit

the 14th century Church of St. John and the Savica Waterfall, both located in the vicinity of Lake Bohinj. The Savica Waterfall is the source of the Sava Bohinjka river, immortalised by the greatest Slovenian poet, France Prešeren (1800-1849), in his epic poem The Baptism by the Savica. The price includes transfers, guidance and Bled Gorge admission fees.
