

Mostar and Medjugorje, day tour from Sarajevo



Mostar and Medjugorje tour is daily tour from Sarajevo to one of biggest romancatholic pilgrimage sites in Europe. On our way to Medjugorje with our Bosnia local guides we will visit Mostar town and its remarkable bridge, Old Bridge of Mostar. This tour starts in the morning in Sarajevo and includes ride to south regions of

country. On our way to Mostar we will stop in Konjic, optional would be visit to Tito war bunker in case that you already had visited Mostar and you prefer something else. In Konjic we can drink Bosnian coffee in lovely place with amazing panorama of Neretva river and lovely Ottoman bridge. After half an hour break in Konjic we will proceed to Mostar.

Famous Mostar bridge -Then we are arriving in Mostar. Guide will lead your imagination through years of history as you admire the stunning architecture of historic city center that UNESCO inscribed onto the World Heritage List.

Heritage Foundation-We will visit Old Bridge, Koski Mehmed Paša Mosque, from where is most beautiful panorama of Old Bridge, Old Ottoman hammam, Old Bazaar Kujundziluk, lovely architecture of Mostar inspired by stones.

After Mostar only 20 minutes ride will lead us to Medjugorje.

Medjugorje Virgin Mary-The St. James's Church is the central place of worship in Medjugorje and the Apparition Hill, site of the first apparitions, is climbed by most pilgrims visiting the shrine. Along the path, a wooden cross marks the site where the Virgin made the first call to peace.

Medjugorje-For those of You who have never been to Medjugorje, you will experience one of the most spiritual and peaceful places on earth. One of the best descriptions of Medjugorje we have ever heard is: "Medjugorje is a place where Heaven touches the earth". After visiting Medjugorje we are sure you will agree.

The messages attributed to Our Lady of Medjugorje have a strong following among Catholics worldwide. Medjugorje has become one of the most popular pilgrimage sites for Catholics in the world and has turned into Europe's third most important apparition site, where each year more than 1 million people visit.

It has been estimated that 30 million pilgrims have come to Medjugorje since the reputed apparitions began in 1981. Many have reported visual phenomenon including the sun spinning in the sky or changing color and figures such as hearts and crosses around the sun. Some visitors have suffered eye damage while seeking to experience such phenomenon.

Visegrad, Andricgrad and Drvengrad day tour from Sarajevo



Visegrad, Andricgrad and Drvengrad tour from Sarajevo is daily tour and includes visit to interesting places in Bosnia and Herzegovina and Serbia.

Visegrad is small town full of pretty streets but we will dedicate our visit to The Old Stone Bridge, the endowment of Grand Vizier Mehmed Pasha Sokolovic. He is one of the great Ottoman military leaders of Bosnian origin. The Bridge is one of the most important national monuments of Bosnia and

Herzegovina, and was entered in the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites in 2007. Ivo Andric, Winner of the 1961 Nobel Prize in Literature, wrote the famous novel “The Bridge on the Drina”. It is a historical novel. The story spans about four centuries and covers the Ottoman and Austro-Hungarian periods of the region, with a particular emphasis on the lives, destinies and relations of the local inhabitants. The Bridge symbolizes strength, permanence and stability in spite of all disasters. It is amazing what such a building or the river below it goes through during the centuries. Just nearby this famous bridge is another tourist attraction – Andricgrad (Andric town) also known as Kamengrad (Stonetown).

Andricgrad is a project of a famous film director Emir Kusturica, inspired by works and characters of mentioned famous writer, Nobel prize winner, Ivo Andric. It is a tourist, cultural, administrative and educational complex, situated on a peninsula between the rivers Drina and Rzav in Visegrad. It is actually a vision of how Visegrad would have looked like if the Renaissance and other historical periods had not gone by it.

We will visit Dobrun Monastery was restored by Despot Stefan Lazarevic and Princess Milica. Sometime on the turn of the 18th and the 19th century Dobrun Monastery was deserted. During its history Dobrun Monastery was several times destroyed and rebuilt. Dobrun Monastery experienced its worst destruction during the Second World War when Germans used it as ammunition storage and blown up in 1945 on their withdrawal. Dobrun Monastery was restored in 1946.

We will finish the tour by visiting third place – Ethnos Village Drvengrad. Drvengrad means wooden town and that’s exactly what you’ll find here. Everything is made of timber from conifer trees. The village is also known by name Kustendorf and means “a coastal village” but it’s also a wordplay on his own name: Kustu – dorf or the village of Kustu (Kusturica’s nickname). It is located in the Zlatibor region in a nature park Mokra Gora, in Serbia. It’s a traditional village, built by mentioned film director Emir Kusturica.

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Orlovača cave and Jahorina mountain day tour



Orlovača cave and Jahorina mountain is daily tour you will visit most significant cave in Sarajevo surrounding area and Olympic mountain that hosted Olympic games in Sarajevo in year 1984.

Orlovača cave is 25 minutes away from Sarajevo. Short ride in east direction will lead us to Orlovača cave. The cave is easy to reach and is only 18 kilometers from the center of Sarajevo. It is located on Orlovača Hill, near the village of Sumbulovac and is about a kilometer from the road that runs between Sarajevo and Zvornik.

Orlovača Cave is best known for its incredibly rich array of decorative cave formations (stalactites and stalagmites), as well as for the Mesolithic pottery shards that have been found here. The temperature inside the cave remains at a constant 9°C, and the area around the cave is perfect for walking, as well as for having picnics near the small stream that flows nearby.

Orlovača is unique for the remains of Cave Bears (*Ursus spelaeus*) that have been found here. These bears inhabited the surrounding hills more than 16,000 years ago. The cave is also home to bats.

The cavern has a total length of more than two and a half kilometers but the area reserved for tourists runs for only 560 meters and includes well-lit concrete paths. After Orlovača cave tour we will proceed to Olympic mountain Jahorina. Guide will talk you about Olympic games and women disciplines competition that was organized on this mountain.

Jahorina Olympic Ski Resort is the biggest and most popular ski resort in Bosnia and Herzegovina and offers a variety of outdoor sports and activities. It is primarily a destination for alpine skiing, snowboarding, hiking, and sledding, with over 40 km (25 mi) of ski slopes and modern facilities. The average snow depth on ski runs during February is 106 cm (42 in) (ten-year average).

After free time on this beautiful mountain we are returning to Sarajevo in afternoon hours.

Free Walking tour Sarajevo



Join us for Free Walking tour Sarajevo that starts every day at 10:30. This is one of best tours in Sarajevo. We start in front of our office which is located on the crossroad of Gazi Husrev begova (Jewerly) street and Mula Mustafa Baseskija street. Discover city in two hours during Sarajevo Free walking tour. We will see Old Orthodox Church, one of the oldest churches in Sarajevo. This church is pilgrimage.

The most recognizable landmark of Sarajevo is Sebilj, wooden fountain located on Baščaršija square. The legend says that drinking water from here means that You will come back in Sarajevo surely again. You will find oldest street in Sarajevo, and walk through Baščaršija. Baščaršija is the main square constructed in 15th century.

During Free walking tour Sarajevo organized by Meet Bosnia Travel you can expect to find oldest and biggest mosque in Sarajevo known as Gazi Husrev-bey. Nearby the most beautiful mosque in Europe find unique Clock Tower famous by showing totally unusual time for XX century. We will walk through oldest shopping center in Sarajevo “Bezistan” – old bazaar from Ottoman period.

Sarajevo City Hall is the most beautiful Austro-Hungarian-era building. From 1949 the building became the National Library. The building now houses the national and university libraries, the city council, and a museum.

Listen to story of Jewish community that is existing in Sarajevo for almost five centuries. Do you know that in Sarajevo there was no geto for Jews? Old Jewish temple is in Old Town and it has interesting museum related to Jewish traditions and customs in Balkans.

After spot that says “Sarajevo Meeting of Cultures” Free Walking tour Sarajevo will continue in direction of modern part of Sarajevo connected to arrival of Habsburg monarchy. Sarajevo, Meeting of Cultures tour shows Cathedral and statue of Pope John Paul II who visited Bosnia two times. Visit the first modern hotel in Sarajevo and listen stories about first Waltz dance and celebrities that stayed here. Recommendation is to drink Bosnian coffee and Sacher cake in this place where east cultures meet west cultures. Tour goes on famous Latin Bridge, Franz-Ferdinand’s assassination sit
